RESOLUTION NO. 2003-02

A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 03, 2003, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING THREE (3) PROPOSITIONS TO INCREASE THE SALES TAX FOR THE VILLAGE OF WEBBERVILLE.

WHEREAS, a special election was held in the Village of Webberville, Texas, on May 03, 2003, for the purpose of adopting three (3) propositions; and

WHEREAS, said election was duly and legally held in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of said election have been verified and returned by the proper judges and clerks, and

WHEREAS, appears that a total of 310 votes were cast in such election; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WEBBERVILLE, STATE OF TEXAS:

Section 1. The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Resolution are hereby found to be true and correct.

Section 2. The official canvass of the returns of the special election held on May 03, 2003, reflects that the following propositions received the number of votes set below their names in the respective positions:

PROPOSITION 1 - A ONE PERCENT SALES AND USE TAX.

PROPOSITION 2 - AN ADDITIONAL SALES AND USE TAX AT THE RATE OF ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT.

FOR	AGAINST
65	39

PROPOSITION 3 - ANOTHER LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX AT THE RATE OF ONE-FOURTH OF ONE PERCENT TO PROVIDE REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF MUNICIPAL STREETS.
