

**Please Note: PENAL CODE SECTION § 37.10. TAMPERING WITH GOVERNMENTAL RECORD.**

Penal Code section 37.10 provides that a person commits an offense if he, among other things, "tampers with, intentionally destroys, conceals, removes, or otherwise impairs the verity, legibility, or availability of a governmental record." **An offense under Penal Code section § 37.10 ranges from a misdemeanor to a state jail felony.**
