1. Call to Order

- a. Greetings

2. Citizen Presentations

The Village Commission welcomes public comments at this point on items not specifically listed on the agenda. Speakers must sign up before the meeting begins. Speakers are limited to three (3) minutes each. The Commission cannot respond to matters not listed on the agenda until a future meeting.

- a. Requesting Public Input related to the possible erection of a 195’ cell tower on the Village property.

3. Administrative

- a. Discuss the possibility of issuing a mass-gathering permit to the Texas Music River Ranch for the proposed ROT Rally event.

4 Public Safety

- a. Request to TxDOT for an intersection warning sign and light on FM 969 for Webberwood Way and Webberwood Dr intersections.
- b. Follow-up on the status of the creation of a neighborhood watch in addition to Nextdoor.

5. Land Use

- a. Review and discuss the lease agreement for the possible erection of a cell tower on the Village property.
- b. Review the revised PDD and associated documents related to the rezoning of the Las Monarcas subdivision and schedule a public hearing for the adoption and approval of the rezoning.
- c. Discuss status of the Sansom-Coe triangle at FM 969 and Post Oak Rd.; traffic impact analysis, proposed plans for a convenience store and gas station.
- d. Discuss status of the Webberville Community General Store and gas station at FM 969 and Webberwood Dr.

6. Election

- a. Discuss and possibly adopt a Resolution that during the election, the entity conducting the election must provide at least one accessible voting system in each polling place used.

7. Public Works

- a. Brief the Village Commission on the latest status of the Village Roads and ROW’s (Right of Ways) and the associated equipment.
- b. Discuss the reply to Manville Water Supply’s proposal of doing cuts into a Village street, Water St. and excavating within Village ROW’s (Right-of-Ways) to run proposed water lines.
- c. Discuss possible repairs needed to Village Hall.
