ORDINANCE NO. 2006 - 07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF WEBBERVILLE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE 2006 AD VALOREM TAX RATE AND LEVY OF \$0.275 PER ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS OF ASSESSED VALUATION OF ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES AND INTEREST; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR ENGROSSMENT AND ENROLLMENT; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a budget appropriating revenues generated by the collection of ad valorem for the use and support of the municipal government of the Village of Webberville has been approved and adopted by the Village of Webberville Commission as required by Section 102.009 of the Texas Local Government Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF WEBBERVILLE, TEXAS:

Section 1 - Approval of 2006 Tax Rate and Levy

That there be and is hereby levied and shall be assessed and collected for the year 2006, on all taxable property, real, personal and mixed, situated within the city limits of the Village of Webberville, Texas, and not exempt by the Constitution of the State and valid state laws, an ad valorem tax rate of Twenty-seven and one half Cents (\$0.275) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) assessed value of taxable property, and shall be apportioned and distributed as follows:

- (a) For the purpose of defraying the current expenses and budget of the municipal government of the City (maintenance and operation), a tax rate of Twenty-seven and one half Cents (\$0.275) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) assessed value of taxable property.

Section 2 - Penalty and Interest

All taxes shall become a lien upon the property against which assessed and the City Tax Assessor/Collector for the Village of Webberville, Texas shall by virtue of the tax rolls, fix and establish a lien by levying upon such property, whether real or personal, for the payment of said taxes, penalty and interest, and the penalty and interest collected from such delinquent taxes shall be appropriated for the general fund of the Village of Webberville, Texas

Section 3 - Cumulative Clause

This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances of the Village of Webberville, Texas, except where the provisions of this Ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed.

Section 4 - Severability Clause

That if any section, subsection, paragraph, clause, phrase, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or provision thereof, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 5 - Savings Clause

That all previous budget ordinances shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this Ordinance.

Section 6- Engrossment and Enrollment

The Village Clerk of the Village of Webberville is hereby directed to engross and enroll this Ordinance by copying the caption, publication clause, penalty clause, and effective date clause in the minutes of the Village Commission of the Village of Webberville and by filing this Ordinance in the ordinance records of the City.

Section 7- Publication Clause

The Village Clerk of the Village of Webberville, Texas, is hereby directed to publish in the Official newspaper of the Village of Webberville, the caption, and effective date clause of this Ordinance as required by Section 52.011 of the Texas Local Government Code.


Section 8 - Effective Date


