

VILLAGE OF WEBBERVILLE

ORDINANCE No. 2011-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF WEBBERVILLE, TEXAS, SETTING A PROPERTY (AD VALOREM) TAX RATE AND APPROVING THE 2012 AD VALOREM TAX RATE AND LEVY OF (\$0.3025) PER ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) OF ASSESSED VALUATION OF ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a budget appropriating revenues generated for the use and support of the municipal government of the Village of Webberville has been approved and adopted by the Webberville Village Commission as required by Section 102.009 of the Texas Local Government Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF WEBBERVILLE, TEXAS AS FOLLOWS:

1. APPROVAL OF 2011-2012 TAX RATE & LEVY

That there be and is hereby levied and shall be assessed and collected for the year 2011-2012, on all taxable property, real, personal and mixed, situated within the city limits of the Village of Webberville, Texas (Village), and not exempt by the Constitution of the State and valid state laws, an ad valorem tax rate of \$0.3025 Cents on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) assessed value of taxable property, and shall be apportioned and distributed as follows:

- (a) For the purpose of defraying the current expenses and budget of the municipal government of the Village (maintenance and operations), a tax rate of \$0.2272 on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) assessed value of taxable property.
- (b) For the purpose of creating a sinking fund to pay the interest and principal maturities on all outstanding debt of the Village of Webberville, not otherwise provided for, a tax of \$0.0753 on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed value of taxable property within the Village of Webberville and shall be applied to the payment of interest and maturities of all such outstanding debt.

2. EXEMPTIONS

The tax exemptions previously adopted by the Village Commission remain in effect.

3. CUMULATIVE CLAUSE

This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances of the Village of Webberville, Texas, except where the provisions of this Ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed.

4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

That if any section, subsection, paragraph, clause, phrase, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or provision thereof, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

5. SAVINGS CLAUSE

That all previous budget ordinances, including exemptions listed therein, shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this Ordinance.

6. ENGROSSMENT & ENROLLMENT

The Village Clerk of the Village of Webberville is hereby directed to engross and enroll this Ordinance by copying the caption, publication clause, penalty clause, and effective date clause in the minutes of the Village Commission of the Village of Webberville and by filing this Ordinance in the ordinance records of the Village.

7. PUBLICATION CLAUSE

The Village Clerk of the Village of Webberville, Texas, is hereby directed to publish the caption, and effective date clause of this Ordinance as required for Village Ordinances.

8. EFFECTIVE DATE

The necessity for making and approving a tax rate for the fiscal year, as required by the laws of the State of Texas, requires that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as the law in such case provides.

9. PROPER NOTICE & MEETING


